Section 1 – The Exterior

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do any trees or other shrubbery obscure the view of your doors and / or windows from the street?
2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Does shrubbery or other structures provide a place where an intruder could hide undetected?
3.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Does your residence's appearance give the impression that no one is home? (uncollected mail, newspapers, cob webs, etc.)
4.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are all outdoor storage sheds, poolhouses, or other exterior buildings kept securely locked when not in use?
5.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are all garage doors, vehicular and pedestrian, kept closed and locked at all times?
6.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do you have a privacy fence or wall with adequately secured gates?
7.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are the house address numbers at least 4" tall, with a contrasting background, and mounted to be clearly visible from the street?
8.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Is the electrical circuit box adequately locked or secured to prevent tampering with fuses or circuit breakers?
9.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there ground floor doors or windows which are open, unlocked, have broken glass or are otherwise inviting to an intruder?
10.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there second floor windows or doors which are open or obviously unlocked?
11.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there any other openings to your home such as skylights, crawl spaces or vents that are unprotected?
12.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are all entrances to your home illuminated with at least 60-watt or higher light bulbs?
13.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there other areas around your home that are unlighted and could provide concealment for an intruder?
14.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are cars or other vehicles left outside that are unlocked or have keys in the ignition?
15.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are valuables or other items of interest left in plain view within any vehicles parked outside?

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are all exterior doors solid core hardwood or metal covered?
2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are all exterior doors secured using high security deadbolt locks with a minimum of a 1" long bolt and high security strike plates?
3.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are the exterior doors hinged so the pin connecting the two hinge pieces is on the inside?
4.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are the exterior door frames and door hardware strong enough to withstand excessive force?
5.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Is there a wide angle peep-hole viewer in all doors where visitors are admitted?
6.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are there windows in the access doors or within 40 inches of the locking mechanisms?
7.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Is the sliding glass door locked by placing a pole or board in the floor track to prevent it from being opened from the outside?
8.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Has the sliding glass door been modified to prevent it from being lifted up and removed from the track?
9.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do all windows have adequate primary and secondary locking mechanisms in good operating condition?
10.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are the sliding windows locked by placing a pole or bar in the track to restrict or prevent them from being pried open from the outside?
11.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are any louvered windows covered with a window grille or grate?
12.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are casement windows securely locked?
13.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Are basement windows secured with a second lock or covered with a grate or grille?
14.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do all of the garage access doors (overhead and pedestrian) have adequate locking devices?

1.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do you check your doors and windows each time before you leave home to insure they are closed and locked?
2.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do you keep your doors and windows locked when you are home?
3.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Do you check your doors and windows at least once a day to insure they are closed and locked?
4.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When away from home do you leave your window shades or blinds open?
5.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When away from home do you leave a radio on and tuned to a talk only station?
6.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When your home is not occupied in the evening hours after dark, do you have lights which are controlled by timers?
7.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When you answer the door do you find out who is on the other side of the door before you unlock or open the door?
8.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When you talk on the phone to strangers do you avoid giving answers or making statements which would help the caller gain access to your residence or to you?
9.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	When you record your greeting on the telephone answering machine do you take care not to give out information about why you did not answer the phone?
